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## **Introduction**

Adani Green Energy Limited (AGEL) has proposed to be setting up of 74 Windmills in and around the periphery of the harbor in Adani South and West Port at APSEZ, Mundra Taluka, Kutch District, Gujarat state. Generated power will be supplied to Mundra Port and through this continuous effort to make Mundra Port as World's first Green Port. However, the site is located 48 km (approx.) South of Bhuj town in Gujarat.

The total electricity generation capacity of the windmills will be in a range between 125.8 MW to 155.4 MW. The land for installation of windmills will be on sub-lease from Adani Ports and Special Economic Zone (APSEZ).

The Gujarat Coastal Zone Management Authority (GCZMA) has recommended the project vide letter No. ENV-10-2016-118-E (T cell) dated no. 06.04.2017.

Accordingly, Coastal Regulation Zone (CRZ) Clearance has been accorded to Adani Green Energy Limited for "Sea Shore Based Wind Power (Windmills) Project" at APSEZ, Taluka Mundra, Kutch, Gujarat vide Letter no F.No.11-19/2017-IA.III dated 06.03.2019.

AGEL has developed & installed Wind Turbine Generator (WTG) Towers outside the CRZ area.

MoEFCC vide letter dated 18.02.2020 has communicated that the CRZ Clearance held in abeyance and the letter dated 18.02.2020 has now been declared effective.
